What to expect on the Saturday that you volunteer:

 Until Noon There are two areas in which to work - Sorting and Packing or Warehouse Descriptions of each are listed below.

Sorting and Packing	Warehouse
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sitting or standing • Heated or air conditioned area, well lit • Trained medical leader directs work • Remove donated medical supplies from boxes • Put like items together in standardized boxes for shipping • Examples: Ace bandages, gauze, sterile drapes • Print label and apply to outside of the box • Stack boxes to store in the warehouse 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Walking, moving boxes, stacking donations • No heat or air conditioning, dusty • Clean and package donated durable equipment • Examples: hospital beds, bedside tables, crutches, and walkers • Put sorted equipment on pallets and store in warehouse • Load equipment and medical supplies in a shipping container to be sent overseas
